



Eaton Square Mayfair Appearance Regulations and Uniform Lists

All pupils should be aware that the School expects high standards of appearance at all times. These regulations apply throughout the school day, including when travelling to and from school. The School operates a uniform service through Perry uniform (www.perryuniform.co.uk). Items marked with a * must be purchased.

Please note that all clothes MUST be properly labelled.

Boys

- Navy/royal stripe suit jacket*
- Navy/royal stripe suit trousers*
- ESM long sleeved shirt*
- V-necked school pullover*
- School tie*
- Plain navy socks
- Clean, polished, black leather shoes (not boots or trainer type shoes)
- Smart dark (black, navy or dark grey) coat (optional)
- Black, navy blue or dark grey school bag (rucksack recommended) or brown leather satchel

Girls

- Navy/royal stripe suit jacket*
- Navy/royal stripe suit skirt* (must sit on the knee)
- ESM long sleeve blouse*
- V-necked school pullover*
- Navy/gold formal scarf*
- Dark blue/black tights or dark blue ankle socks (NOT sports shoe liner socks or long socks).
- Sensible polished black leather shoes with heels not more than 3cm high. (Suede shoes, stiletto/kitten heels, boots, and trainer type shoes are not allowed)
- Smart dark (black, navy or dark grey) coat (optional)
- Black, navy blue or dark grey school bag (rucksack recommended) or brown leather satchel

General points relating to appearance

Girls:

- Jewellery must be kept to an absolute minimum and no valuables are encouraged at school. The only piercings permitted are one piercing placed centrally on each earlobe. Earrings should be of simple stud or small sleeper design. No necklaces, bracelets or rings are allowed.
- No jewellery may be worn for games. Jewellery remains the responsibility of the pupil and sports staff will not look after any personal items.
- Nails must be kept short and neat. No nail varnish is permitted.



- Hair must be its natural colour, though subtle and natural highlights or lowlights are permitted. Hair, if shoulder length or longer, must be tied back throughout the day. Hair should not have beads or threads braided in.
- Make up must be absolutely minimal and natural looking. Girls may be asked to remove make-up if it is considered to be excessive.

Boys:

- No piercings or jewellery are permitted whatsoever.
- Hair should be kept clean, tidy, above the collar and should not be dyed. Razor cuts of 2 or below, visible shaved lines, any notable difference in hair length on sides and tops and any form of exaggerated quiffs are strictly prohibited. Pupils who come to school with inappropriate hairstyles may be required to return home until this has been rectified.
- Boys must be clean-shaven at all times. If not, they will be asked to shave at school or, for repeated offences, sent home. No sideburns are permitted.

The Head's (Upper or Lower) decision about whether any form of dress is acceptable is final. Pupils will be warned if their dress is not appropriate and they should immediately correct it. Repeated failure to adhere to these guidelines will result in sanctions and/or uniform monitoring.

Games Kit

The following games kit items are compulsory to purchase. There are a number of additional items which pupils may wish to have depending on the particular sports they participate in over the course of the academic year.

Girls:

Boys:

Mouthguards and shin pads are mandatory. One padlock is required for each pupil's locker. This must be bought into school on the first day. Particular dress regulations may apply for school trips. The decision as to what is acceptable in such situations lies with the member of staff in charge of the trip.
